WHAT IS A SMALL GROUP?

There are a number of small groups in our church. Typically each group consists of 10-12 people who regularly meet at various members' homes. For the time being, all groups will initially meet online until further notice. A typical meeting may consist of singing praises, studying the Bible, learning, serving, sharing, praying and refreshments. It is a common understanding amongst the group members to respect sharing in confidence. Many groups host special events and enjoy outings and retreats together.

There are different types of group settings to meet the diverse needs of our church. Please look through the group descriptions to find out more details. Small groups provide an opportunity for us to fellowship and journey through life with people of all ages and various stages of life, giving a deeper and more profound experience of what it means to be the family of God together in this place.

AQA APOLOGETICS Q&A

The purpose of AQA is to reach out to seekers, especially those in STEMM professions (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, Medicine), and to strengthen the faith of all Christians with a fresh perspective on the Creator of the Universe.

People are welcome to drop in and highly encouraged to invite their seeker friends. We will watch a seeker friendly apologetic video or video series for the first 30 to 45 minutes, then have Q&A on any audience topic for 30 to 45 minutes. After Q&A, the seekers are welcome to stay for further fellowship and prayer in breakout groups.

Videos and topics range from: Does God Exist, Origins, Scientific Interpretation of Genesis, Creation vs Evolution, the Resurrection, the Trinity, Predestination, and Suffering. Answers are from a scientific, philosophical, old earth creationist, and Biblical perspective.

CORNERSTONE FELLOWSHIP

We are an 'open' fellowship group of mature members who foster our three ministry areas of **Supporting**, **Encouraging**, **and Caring** by:

A. Going Broader - to welcome people outside our group; andB. Going Deeper in our relationship with Christ and each other.

During the COVID-19 situation, we meet as a large group once a month via Zoom. The large group is also divided into several cell groups of maximum 6 members. Each cell group meets once a month virtually or physically (in accordance with Provincial social distancing guidelines). The large group Zoom meeting will reflect on the Sunday sermons that involves discussion, sharing, and application. The cell group gathering is intended to promote deeper sharing and prayer. When the COVID-19 restriction is lifted, the large group will meet at the church.
