Introduction

Are you looking for a summer ministry job opportunity? If so, please read on! One of our desires as a church is to build up people in ministry skills, Godly character and biblical knowledge. We do this through mentoring for spiritual maturity. In this spirit, our church has applied for and received approval from Service Canada (Federal Government) for Canada Summer Job positions.

Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) is an initiative under Canada's Youth Employment Strategy. CSJ provides funding to not-for-profit, public and small private sector employers with 50 or fewer employees to create summer job opportunities for young people aged 15-30 years old.

Canada Summer Jobs is about:

- Supporting work experiences for young people
- Supporting organizations including those that provide important community services; and
- Recognizing that local circumstances, community needs and priorities vary widely.

To be eligible, you must:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act, and,
- be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.

Job Description and Responsibilities:

The Youth Ministry Assistant will be a post-high school student who will be responsible to assist in the training of volunteers, help organize weekly youth group meetings, organize a neighbourhood outreach involving teens from the church, and help facilitate youth leadership training.

Weekly Youth Group Meetings

Every week, the youth ministry plans an open event for teens in our community. The Youth Ministry Assistant will work with the supervisor in the planning and implementation of the outreach program. This includes planning of games, activities, and lessons.

Community Outreach Project

The Youth Ministry Assistant will organize a neighbourhood outreach project where teens from the church will be involved in various activities throughout the neighbourhood, and can invite neighbours to join community activities provided in the church. Many youth in the neighbourhood come from multicultural and financially challenged backgrounds.

Leadership Training

The Youth Ministry Assistant will assist the supervisor in mentorship and leadership training of young leaders as they prepare for the start of the school year youth ministry program.

The Youth Ministry Assistant will not only help with administrative organization but also develop connections with our community neighbours through web and social media platforms. Learn and assist in video production for our online Sunday services and other social media content during the pandemic.
