

The Armor of God: Belt of Truth Ephesians 6:10-12, 14; Acts 5:17-42



Here's what happens...

Paul talks about the spiritual battle we're fighting against evil and tells us to put on God's armor. This includes the belt of truth. In Acts, Peter and John put on the belt of truth when they spread the truth about Jesus despite being arrested and beaten.

Bible Point:

We fight evil with truth.

"Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm" (Ephesians 6:13).

Family Together Time

- Write out a Bible verse with a truth your family needs to be reminded of.
- Add a symbol that represents the verse if you have kids who can't read.
- Hang it on a door, mirror, or the fridge so you'll be reminded of the truth all week!
- Try these verses, or choose your own:
 - Romans 12:18: "Do all that you can to live in peace with everyone." (Draw two people holding hands.)
 - 1 John 3:1: "See how very much our Father loves us, for he calls us his children, and that is what we are!" (Draw a heart.)
 - Romans 8:28: "And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them." (Draw a smiley face.)
