

Lytton Easter Boxes Decoration

Thank you for being part of this Easter Box initiative for Lytton. We believe a Box that is thoughtfully and beautifully decorated plays an important part in extending our love to the Lytton evacuees – it is a prelude to the caring gifts that is within.

Please find below the decoration guidelines and suggested ideas:

- Please decorate all four sides of the box, but not the top and bottom.
- Do not tape the box, please leave the box flat as when you picked up the box.
- ***Return the decorated box to Fraser Lands Church by Sunday, March 20, 2022.***
- Keep the decoration cheerful and light-hearted.
 - Decorate with spring or bright colours.
 - Draw or use cut outs such as bunnies, ducks, kittens, Easter eggs ... anything that says Spring, hope, and new life. If drawing, use markers rather than pastels which can rub and smear. Inexpensive cut outs can be purchased from Dollar Stores.
- If you are decorating with panels of wrapping paper, please use heavy duty decent quality wrapping paper & have it securely taped. The boxes will be handled many times before they arrive at their destinations.
- Do not do a Good Friday theme, such as 3 crosses, a dark sky, a nail in a hand or a crown of thorns, etc.
